Responsibility Title:	Onsite English Teacher
Hours:	9.00am - 5.00 pm

Summary of the responsibility:

This role has a specific responsibility of delivering English/literacy to a high standard to students on a 1:1 basis (or small groups) in our hubs. Working with students of all ages, abilities and needs, who will attend the centre for one session per week, the role also supervises a team of offsite teachers who deliver English to the same students, complimenting the work done onsite and ensuring student progress.

The role also works closely with their colleagues in the English team and the English Lead to train, develop, mark and oversee the smooth running of the department.

This responsibility is in addition to the standard TCW Teacher responsibilities.

Onsite 1:1/small group English Teacher Responsibilities:

1. Deliver 1:1/small group English lessons to up to 20 assigned students throughout the week
2. Liaise with and support offsite teachers working with your assigned students and oversee their further delivery of the English curriculum to your students
3. Oversee your assigned students' English progress
4. Support the English Lead in the smooth running of the department including training, moderating and curriculum development

Person Specification:

Essential

- This responsibility is available to any TCW staff on or starting a salaried contract with the school
- A-level (or equivalent) or above in an English subject
- Comprehensive experience of teaching English curriculum to students with behavioural and/or Special Educational Needs

Desirable

- Degree or above in English

The responsibility description is not an exhaustive list and there may be times when the Chief Executive Officer or Headteacher will require certain tasks to be undertaken that may not be listed here. These will always fall within the policies and procedures of TCW and within the remit of what may be expected in your role. There will always be a discussion between all parties on whether the successful candidate feels they can manage these extra tasks. This responsibility and the remuneration associated with it is in addition to your contracted salaried position, and either party (TCW or yourself) can give 6 months notice of the termination of this responsibility.
